

#### FOOD CUPBOARD NEWS . . .

We want to thank Glen Xavier and his father Arul Xavier for their association with an organization named Charity Crossing. Through their association, Glen and Arul were able to obtain a large amount of new winter clothing that they then offered at our food cupboard opening on Saturday, February 19<sup>th</sup>. We heard many thanks for this service from our food cupboard families. It is service like this from community individuals and organizations that make our food cupboard a true outreach to Hatfield and surrounding areas.

That's the good news, now for some sobering news. We are all aware of the devastating circumstances due to COVID 19. However, for our food cupboard, the government's response COVID 19 has been quite helpful. We have been able to obtain two glass door refrigeration units, two laptops, large grants to purchase additional products like: meats, fresh produce, cleaning supplies, paper products. Additionally, we were able to receive increased amounts of food from federal, state, county, and local governments, through our supporting agencies: SHARE, Philabundance, MAHN, and Township Police. Additionally, we have seen an increase in individual food donations.

However, these COVID related increases are gone or will soon to be gone. Additionally, the monies and services from the government agencies that we enjoyed prior to COVID will be reduced as well. Food distributors that were willing to sell to the government for a reduce amount are no longer willing to sell. They are able to receive much larger revenues from the private sector and/or the supply chain has drastically slowed limiting what distributors can obtain. Canned foods are not affected as much as fresh produce.

While monies are decreasing, families in need are not decreasing. What will be most helpful for the food cupboard is financial donations: individuals and corporate. We would appreciate your help.
